

Will of Giles Ibell, Yeoman, Shelswell Barton. 13 April 1769

to wife Mary until son Richard becomes 21 all my stock of cattle corne hay in or about the mess and farm at Barton now in my occ which I rent of [blank] Sheldon Esquire  
also stock of sheep at my farm at Hempton  
wife to manage crops etc towards maintenance and breeding up of my two sons William and Richard until Richard becomes 21  
Sons shall then pay my wife £5 a year throughout her life  
to eldest son Joseph stock of cattle at Hempton  
Joseph to pay my wife £5 a year  
to Joseph and William £100, interest to my daughter Mary Falkner for her own sole and separate use not to be used for debts or engagements of her present or any after taken Husband  
Joseph and William to pay £100 to children or grandchildren of Mary Falkner  
to wife for life the use usage and reasonable wear of my household goods at Shelswell Barton and after her death to sons William and Richard  
to Joseph all household goods at Hempton  
Legacies and funeral expenses to be paid by all three sons

Codicil [in uneducated hand] I dezer son Joseph to pay to son Richard £20 when he resines up the Coppey hold Land and if my son Richard will not resine hee shall pay the money I gave ? to son Joseph Ibell
